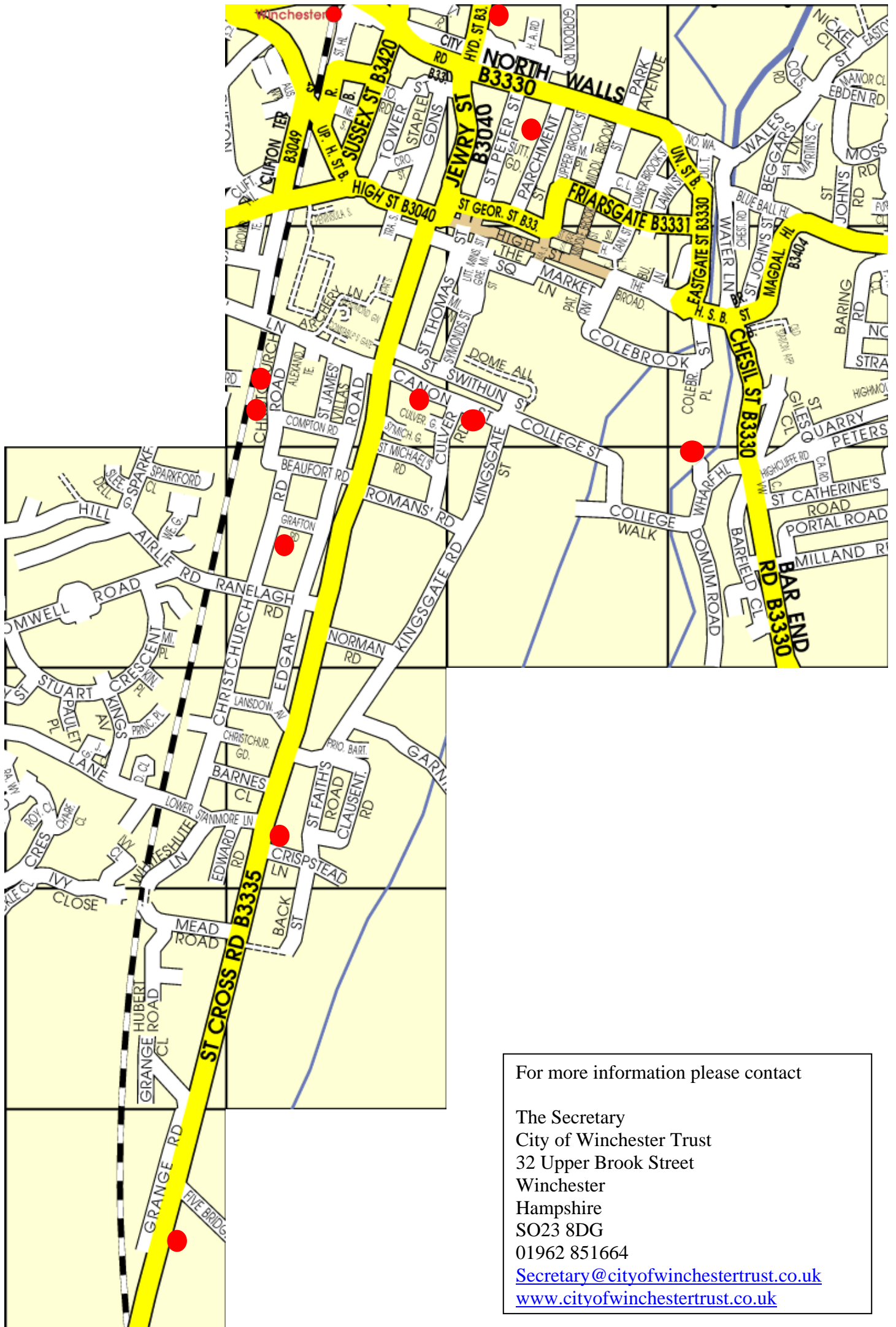
These gardens represent the wide variety of contexts, garden landscapes and settings within Winchester.
